GETTING STARTED

H&I

- 1. Simply remove the battery cover.
- 2. Press On/OFF key.

Using the Thermometer

- Alert. Default Alert setting of the KTH06 is Alert On. Press the "ALERT" button on the backside of the device to turn off the temperature alert function, and the alert icon will disappear on the LCD.
- **The temperature setting**. Press the "+" or "-" button to adjust the temperature setting. Hold the "+" or "-" button to adjust the setting fast.
- Setting range is from ~4 482°F.(~20~250°C) When the cooking temperature has reached the alert temperature, the buzzer begins to alert with a sound. Press any button to stop the alert. 3.1 High (H) Alert Mode
- Default setting is High Alert mode. When the cooking temperature is at target or higher, the buzzer begins to alert with a sound. Press any button to stop the
- 3.2 Low (L) Alert Mode
- If you need to monitor a temperature from high to low, long press Alert Button for 3 seconds. Alert icon will change to L. When the cooking temperature is at target or lower, the buzzer begins to alert with a sound. Press any key to turn it off. If 30seconds later, the temperature is still below target, it will alert again.
- Cooking Temperatures. Find your desired target temperatures in the chart included in this manual.
- 5. **C/F Change**. To change the temperature unit from C to F or from F to C, open the battery cover and slide the switch either C or F as required.
- Backlight. Press the Light key to turn the backlight on or off. In order to save the pattery, we suggest to only turn on the light when needed.
- 7. **Hold Function**. Press and hold the "Light Key" for 2 seconds, the "Cooking Temp" will disappear and the probe will keep displaying the last temperature reached. If you need to cancel the Hold and keep on monitoring temperature, press and hold "Liaht Kev" for 2 seconds.
- Count down timer. Set the desired time by pressing the Min and Hour keys. To Set the hours, press the Hour key. The display flashes, then press "+" or "-" to set it to desired time.

Press "Hour key" again to confirm. To Set the minutes, press the "Min key". The display flashes, then press "+" or "-" to set it to desired time. Press "Hour key" again

- After you set the desired time, press "Start", count down timer will begin. It will alert once time has run out. Max setting: 99 hours 59 min. Tip: By holding "+" or "-" the time will increase or decrease rapidly.
- 9. Stopwatch function. If you didn't set the count down timer, pressing Start will start counting the time. Press again to pause. Press the Start/Pause key for 2 seconds to

NOTE: The unit itself is not heat resistant. The plastic, screen, batteries and buttons can not withstand heat of more than 150 °F for a short period of time. Therefore do not leave the unit inside the BBQ/Smoker Pit or Oven.

The actual probe and cable can reach very high temperatures, therefore always remember suitable protection against scalding when inserting and removing the probes from any Stove/Oven/BBQ/Smoker or Pit.
